● Only use this product as originally intended. ● For safety, be sure to keep this product away from fingers, hands, face, and hair while blades are rotating. ● Do not insert fingers, etc. into the product's moving parts. Doing so could cause injury. ● Be sure not to bang this object against hard surfaces or drop it. Improper use of batteries may cause leakage, unwanted heat or damage. Please note the following.>
Do not use rechargeable batteries with this product.
Do not mix different types of batteries for use, such as old and new.
Make sure batteries are aligned correctly with the + and - positions.
After use, be sure to press the ON/OFF button to its OFF position, and remove the batteries.
Do not short, recharge, disassemble, or heat up the product, and do not expose it to fire.
If liquid leaking from a battery gets in your eye, immediately flush it out with a large volume of water, and contact a physician. If battery liquid makes contact with skin or clothing, wash with water.
When disposing of batteries, comply with local ordinances of proper disposal.
If the product gets dirty, dampen a cloth with neutral detergent diluted with water, or soapy water, and use it to wipe the product clean.
* Do not use benzine, paint thinner, or alcohol products for cleaning.

<USB Cable>

- The USB cable can be used while batteries are inserted (USB power is prioritized in this case).
- For USB power, be sure to use the included USB cable.
- The included USB cable is designed specifically for this product. Do not use it with any other product.
- If the USB cable is forcefully bent, pulled, tied into a knot, held too close to a heater, or damaged, it may cause a short or fire, and should not be used.
